

AN ACT

To grant the Cabinet authority to set, adjust, and collect reasonable
uses fees.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:

1 Section 1. Short title.

2 This Act may be cited as the Government Fees Act 1964.

3 Section 2. Purpose.

4 The purpose of this Act is to collect reasonable fees to be
5 used only for defraying administrative expenses and not for taxation
6 purposes.

7 Section 3. Fees authority.

8 (1) Where the Cabinet has been given authority to make regulations
9 to give effect to an Act such authority includes the setting, adjusting,
10 and collecting of reasonable fees to be charged for the use and enjoyment
11 of government facilities and services.

12 (2) Where no express regulation-making authority or fee-
14 setting authority is granted to the Cabinet to effectuate and Act, authority
15 is hereby given to set, adjust, and collect reasonable fees to be charged
16 for the use and enjoyment of government facilities and services.

17 (3) Where fees or fee-setting authority are established by
18 Act, the Cabinet is given authority to set, adjust, and collect reasonable
19 fees to be charged for the use and enjoyment of government facilities and
20 services.

21 Section 4. Effective date.

22 This Act becomes effective on the date on which it becomes law.
