

AN ACT

To provide for a revolving fund for rehabilitation of patients.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:

1 Section 1. Short title.

2 This Act may be cited as the Rehabilitation Act 1984.

3 Section 2. The Rehabilitation Fund.

4 (1) A Rehabilitation Fund is hereby esta

5 (2) The Fund is a fund other than the Marshall Islands General
6 Fund within the meaning and for the purpose of Article VIII, Section 5(2)
7 of the Constitution.

8 Section 3. Payments into the Fund.

9 There shall be paid into the Rehabilitation Fund all money
10 received by the Republic from -

11 (a) special grants from overseas; and

12 (b) fees and charges of the Rehabilitation Center; and

13 (c) charitable donations to the Rehabilitation Center; and

14 (d) any amounts appropriated by the Nitijela for the
15 purposes of this Fund.

16 Section 4. Payments out of the Fund.

17 (1) Subject to Section 5, payment may be made out of the Fund
18 for the purchase or rental of prosthetic devices, physical therapy equipment,
19 wheel chairs, crutches, medicines and other rehabilitation equipment use
20 of the patients of the Rehabilitation Center of the Majuro hospital.

21 (2) No money may be withdrawn from the Fund except with the
22 authority of the Secretary of Finance who shall satisfy himself that the
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1 withdrawal is made in accordance with this Act.

2 Section 5. Surpluses.

3 If at any time there is over \$20,000 in the Fund generated
4 from sources exclusively referred to in Section 3(a) and 3(d), the
5 Secretary of Finance may transfer some or all of the surplus from the
6 Rehabilitation Fund into the General Fund.

7 Section 6. Accounts, etc.

8 (1) The Secretary of Finance shall maintain proper records
9 and accounts of the Rehabilitation Fund and the accounts to be laid
10 before the Nitijela under Article VIII, Section 5(4), of the Constitution
11 shall include accounts relating to the Fund.

12 (2) The accounts and records maintained under Subsection 1
13 are subject to audit under Article VIII, Section 15, of the Constitution.

14 Section 7. Effective date.

15 This Act becomes effective on the date on which it becomes law.
