

AN ACT

An Act to amend the Postal Service Act 1983 to exempt the members and employees of the Postal Service from the application of Article VII of the Constitution, and to provide for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:

1 Section 1. Short title and effective date.

2 This Act may be cited as the Postal Service (Amendment) Act
3 1985, and shall come into effect on the date on which it becomes law.

4 Section 2. Subsection 3 of Section 6 is hereby amended by the
5 substitution therefor of the following Subsection.

6 3(a) The Controller of Postal Service shall appoint the
7 members of the Postal Service; or persons to receive,
8 transmit or deliver mail on behalf of the Postal Service
9 upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by
10 him by regulation.

11 (b) The members and other persons employed by the Postal
12 Service shall be paid such compensation and allowances as
13 the Controller of Postal Service may determine by
14 regulation.

15 (c) Article VII of the Constitution shall not apply to or in
16 relation to the members and employees of the Postal
17 Service.

18 (d) At the request of the Minister, however, the Public
