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AN ACT

To provide, in accordance with the Constitution, Article VIII, Section 5, and the Transitional Provisions (Conformity with Trusteeship Agreement) Act, Section 14, for the issue from the Marshall Islands General Fund and the United States Grant General Fund of the sum of \$4,937,700 as a supplementary appropriation for the financial year 1983, and to appropriate sums to program areas, and for related purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE NTIJJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:

1           Section 1. Short title.

2                   This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation  
3 Act (No. 1) (Financial Year 1983).

4           Section 2. Incorporation with the Appropriation Act.

5                   This Act shall be incorporated and read as one with the  
6 Appropriation Act (Financial Year 1983).

7           Section 3. Appropriation of the Department of the Interior Grant.

8                   (1) Subject to Subsection (2), the amount of \$2,621,000  
9 (being the amount of the United States Department of the Interior grant  
10 for the balance of the financial year ) is appropriated and may be  
11 withdrawn from the United States Grant General Fund and expended pursuant  
12 to Sections 10, 12, 13 of the Transitional Provisions (Conformity with  
13 Trusteeship Agreement) Act, and Article VIII of the Constitution, for  
14 the program area for which it was appropriated by the Congress of the  
15 United States, during the financial year ending 31 December 1983.

16                   (2) In the first instance the sum appropriated by Subsection  
17 (1) shall be paid into the Marshall Islands General Fund, and may be  
18 expended only in accordance with Section 5.

19           Section 4. Appropriation of other U.S. grants.

20                   (1) Subject to Subsection (2), the sum of \$750,000 (being

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1 the total amount of special U.S. agency grants for the balance of the  
2 financial year) is appropriated and may be withdrawn from the United  
3 States Grant General Fund and expended pursuant to Sections 10, 12 and 13  
4 of the Transitional Provisions (Conformity with Trusteeship Agreement) Act,  
5 and Article VIII of the Constitution, for the respective program  
6 areas in respect of which it was appropriated by the Congress of the  
7 United States, and in accordance with that appropriation, during the  
8 financial year ending 31 December 1983.

9 (2) No part of the amount referred to in Subsection (1)  
10 is available for expenditure as reprogrammed expenditure under  
11 Section 13 of the Transitional Provisions (Conformity with Trusteeship  
12 Agreement) Act, and Article VIII, Section 7 of the Constitution, except  
13 as authorized by or under the law of the United States.

14 Section 5. Appropriations from the Marshall Islands General Fund.

15 The sum of \$4,187,700, made up of -

16 (a) \$1,556,700, being public money other than money  
17 required, by Section 9 of the Transitional Provisions  
18 (Conformity with Trusteeship Agreement) Act, to be  
19 paid into the United States Grant General Fund; and

20 (b) \$2,621,000, being the amount appropriated out of  
21 the United States Grant General Fund by Section 3,  
22 is appropriated and may be withdrawn from the Marshall Islands General  
23 Fund and expended pursuant to Article VIII of the Constitution for  
24 program areas in accordance with the Schedule during the financial year  
25 ending 31 December 1983.
